**Lion Bob Brooke** is undergoing chemotherapy.

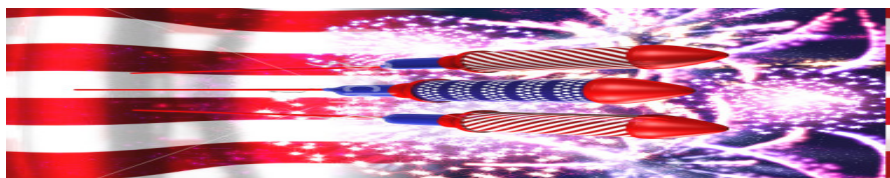
**Lion Roger Mitchell** has been diagnosed with cirrhosis of the liver and has been undergoing treatments.
